- 10 The Lord sits enthroned over the flood; the Lord is enthroned as King forever.
- 11 The Lord gives strength to his people; the Lord blesses his people with peace.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit; as it was in the beginning, is now and shall be forever. Amen
