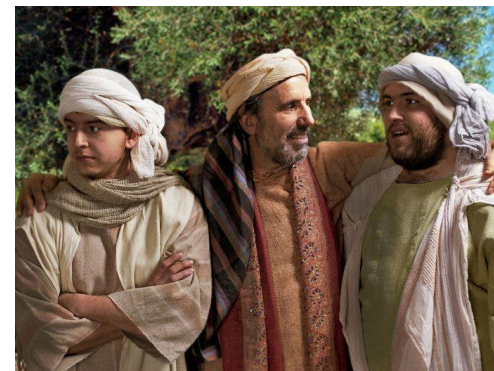

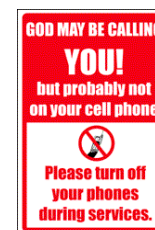


Before the service we speak to God
