The great leveller

Luke 3:1-6

John the Baptist hears God's word and begins a ministry, baptising people as a sign of repentance and telling those he meets that Jesus will be for all people. His work echoes the prophecy in Isaiah, that there will be a voice crying out to prepare the way of the Lord. Isaiah shows that Jesus' message is one of equality - not just for the rich and powerful and not just for the Jews.

Signs are important to us. They can tell us how to behave, where to go- and where not to go! A sign might tell us that the road ahead is bumpy, but probably not that it is smooth! But this week, we are going to see how Jesus is a sign for everyone. That, regardless of who we are and what we do, we are all equal in the sight of God. This week we explore John as a sign that Jesus is for all.

In the tender compassion of our God \*

the dawn from on high shall break upon us,

To shine on those who dwell in darkness and the shadow of death, \* and to guide our feet into the way of peace.

Glory to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit;

as it was in the beginning is now and shall be for ever. Amen.
