The first 100 days

Mark 1.29-39

Jesus shows us his priorities – he knows what he must do and demonstrates this by healing and proclaiming the good news. However, Jesus also takes time out to get away from the crowds and be alone in prayer – he knows what he must do to care for himself and stay true to his mission.

Do we find or make enough time to rest with God? What difference does it make?

PSALM 147

- 1 Praise ye the Lord: for it is good to sing praises unto our God; for it is pleasant; and praise is comely.

- 10 He delighteth not in the strength of the horse: he taketh not pleasure in the legs of a man.
- 11 The Lord taketh pleasure in them that fear him, in those that hope in his mercy.
- 20 He hath not dealt so with any nation: and as for his judgments, they have not known them. Praise ye the Lord.
