NOTICE OF ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

The Annual General Meeting of the Limassol Parish Church, including St Barnabas', Limassol and St Lazarus', Pissouri, will be held in St Barnabas' Church at 11:30 a.m. on Sunday 22nd March 2026. Any person interested in the work of the Church may attend, only those registered on the Membership Roll may vote at the meeting.

The business of the Annual General Meeting is to receive reports from the Chaplain, the Honorary Treasurer, the Wardens and others; to consider and approve the audited accounts of the previous year; to consider, discuss, if necessary revise and adopt the budget for this year; to consider and determine any other matters to do with the welfare of the Church; to elect a People's Warden and Members of the Church Council in order to fill vacancies and to confirm the appointments of Chaplain's wardens.

The People's Warden is elected to serve for one year; there is no limit to the number of times an individual can be re-elected.

Members of the Church Council serve for a term of two years and may be re-elected for a second term

Nominations should be made on the lists with this notice. Nominees, proposers and seconders must be on the Membership Roll, a copy of which is posted in the Porch. The lists will close after the service on Sunday 8th March and the closed lists will be displayed by March 15th

According to Article 2 of the Constitution:

'The Chaplaincy is a community of Anglican and other Christian believers which expresses its will in its Annual General Meetings'

If you would like anything discussed at the meeting an item can be added under Any Other Business by sending details to the Chaplain and Wardens by 11th March. Any discussion items received after this date will be deferred to the next AGM
