Hello AGAPI CYPRUS Supporters!



The Serial Killer tracedy 7 years ago

You may recall the tragedy which happened 7 years ago between 2016-2018 - five women were lured one by one by a Cyprus army officer and then murdered by him - 2 of the women had taken a daughter with them, whom the killer also murdered. The man has been convicted and is serving multiple life sentences in prison. The women were all migrant women domestic workers - 3 Filippinas, 1 Nepalese and 1 Romanian. The police were informed of the disappearances of the women but failed to follow up promptly.

AGAPI CYPRUS under the initiative of Lady Elizabeth Haslam and some members of CIWOT (Cyprus International Women of Today) are intending to erect a memorial/plant a tree with the names of the victims in a public place in Limassol. The mother of one of the victims is known to us but the other families seem to be unknown, are not in Cyprus, etc.
