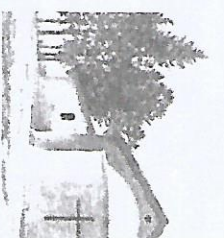

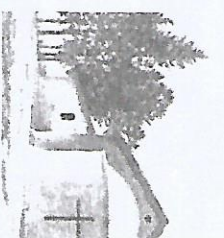

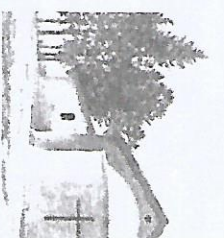

**Outside, inside**

**Mark 7.1-8,14-15,21-23**

Some Pharisees and scribes accuse Jesus' disciples of eating with unwashed hands. Jesus tells the Pharisees that it is what is inside the heart that is important. He says that they honour God with their lips but not their hearts. It not what goes into a person's body that defiles a person, but rather the word and actions that can come from the inside.

The choices we make and the words we speak reflect what is important to us values that we hold. How do the choices we make reflect the values we hold? Who and what influences those values? Today we are thinking about the things that make a healthy, supportive community, and what we need to help us live as disciples.

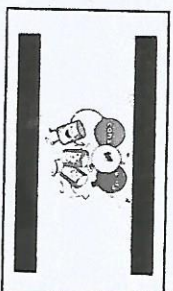
